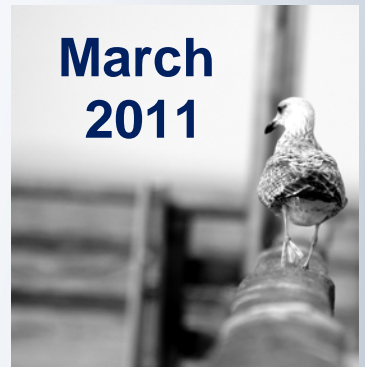
4th Baltic Sea Tourism Forum "Tourism linking Baltic Countries"
